

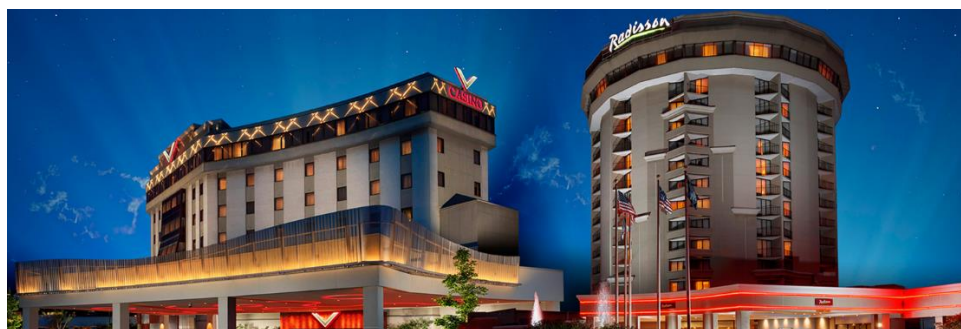

Saturday, July 29, 2017

PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES GAMES (vs Atlanta Braves)

Leave hotel at 5:30pm – return to hotel at 11:00pm (7:05 PM game)

TOUR COST PER PERSON: \$70 (total seats – 47) *Food: On own at the park

Monday, July 31, 2017

PICK YOUR CHOICE OF PHILLY (total seats 47)

Bus will leave the hotel at 9:00 AM and drop off at Zoo First then Constitution Center. Pick up will then be determined at each location based on ticket sales.

STOP #1 – Philly Zoo

Bus will drop off those that purchased pre-purchased tickets for the Philly Zoo

TOUR COST PER PERSON: \$37 (total seats – 47) *Food: On own

STOP #2 – Constitution Center Tour

Tour the Constitution Center then use your pre-sold BIG BUS TICKET to tour the rest of Philly. 27 stops are made and you can stay on the bus and tour the entire city or stop along the way.

Any stop along the way that has additional costs will be paid for by the person at arrival and not done through the session tour committee. Costs for each stop can be provided.

Big Bus Stops include the Betsy Ross House, United States Mint/Ben Franklin's Grave, Chinatown, Reading Terminal Market/Convention Center Marriott/Macy's, City Hall/Love Park, Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter & Paul/Sister Cities, Barnes Foundation, Rodin Museum, Eastern State Penitentiary, Perelman Building of Philadelphia Art Museum, The Philadelphia Zoo, Please Touch Museum/ Memorial Hall/Fairmount Park, "Rocky Steps" Philadelphia Museum of Art East Entrance, Philadelphia Museum of Art- West Entrance, Franklin Institute/Logan Circle, Four Seasons Hotel, The Bellevue/Rittenhouse Square, Academy of Music/Broad Street, Antiques Row, South Street/Head House Square, Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Hyatt Regency Philadelphia at Penn's Landing/Columbus Boulevard, Penn's Landing/Waterfront, Old City/Christ Church, and the Museum of American Jewish History

TOUR COST PER PERSON: \$55 (total seats – 47) *Food: On own

VALLEY FORGE NATIONAL PARK – transportation on your own.

Open 9-6. Trolley tours run for 90 minutes and depart from the front of the Visitor Center. They run at specific times. (10, 12, 2, and 4). These trollies are ADA accessible and stop at several stops along the way. The Park is just 0.6 mile walk from the hotel to the Visitor Center.

COST PER PERSON: \$17.50 (Group rate - \$10 per person if group is larger than 16)

DAY AT GETTYSBURG

Leave hotel at 7:30am – return to hotel at 6:00pm

Bus will transport from hotel to Gettysburg Visitor’s Center where you will get to see a film followed by a 360 degree cyclorama painting and museum exhibits. Then a tour guide will board the bus and take the group onto the Battlefield for a two-hour guided tour. This tour will make a lunch stop along the way.

AMISH EXPERIENCE

Leave hotel at 8:00am – return to hotel at 5:00pm

Lancaster Amish Experience – bus leaves hotel and takes you to the famous Lancaster County Amish country and experience it for yourself firsthand.

Amish Experience Theater (first stop)

Truly a one-of-a-kind experience and only the third theater of its type in North America. “Jacob’s Choice” tells the emotional story of the Fisher family, from 16th century Europe to modern-day America. Ghostly effects, cannon, wind, rain and fire effects immerse you in the world of the Amish. (approx. 40 minutes, shows on the hour.)

Fisher Family Homestead & One-Room School (second stop)

Authenticity and interpretation explain why the Homestead is the only Amish House and Schoolroom designated an official Lancaster County “Heritage Site.” The house tour answers the “how” and “why” of Amish dress, life without electricity, and many other Amish riddles. (approx. 45 minutes)

Amish Farmlands Step-On Guided Tour (third stop)

Visitors the world over know the beauty of our Amish countryside. Not much has changed on our backroads.... horses plow the fields, buggies clip-clop down country lanes. In your coach with driver, our step-on guide reveals Amish life up close with fascinating stops along the way, customized to your group’s interests.

Traditional Family-Style Feast (fourth stop)

Plain & Fancy Farm Dining Room – It's Lancaster County's world-famous original family-style restaurant. Enjoy endless platters of roast beef, delicious golden fried chicken, tasty country sausage, real mashed potatoes, iced raisin bread, shoepeg corn, chow chow, delicious apple dumplings a la mode, chocolate cake, ice cream... all you care to eat without leaving the table!

Session Notes & Reminders



Dress Code:

Appropriate behavior and attire will display a positive image for Job's Daughters International. Proper attire is the responsibility of each person attending Supreme Session. Your wardrobe should fit appropriately and be in good taste. Ladies, short skirts or shorts are not appropriate at any time at Supreme Session.

- Formal Opening and Banquet, Pageant, Supreme Bethel Installation & Supreme Guardian Council are formal events and your attire should reflect that. Attendees should wear formal or dressy dresses for daughters and women, tuxedos or suits for boys and men.
- Attire for Business Meetings and meals (except formal banquet) is business casual. No jeans, t-shirts or shorts. Attendees should wear tops or blouses with slacks or skirts for daughters and women, dress pants or slacks with a collared shirt for boys and men.
- All daughters attending the Supreme Bethel Meeting must be in robe. All adults should be business casual.
- All attendees that choose to use the hotel's pool must wear cover-ups when going to and from the pool area. No string or thong bikinis for daughters and women, no speedos for boy and men.
- Dress code for any other times at Session (in the hotel & tours) is casual. While at Supreme Session you are representing Job's Daughters International and your Jurisdiction. Please use your best judgement on your apparel.

Chaperones:

YPP rules apply at Supreme Session. There must be one CAV for every five daughters. Chaperones are responsible for the daughters assigned to them as well as their dress code, behavior and location. No daughters may leave the hotel without a Chaperone.

Quiet Hours:

We ask that everyone adhere to quiet hours in the hotel hallways and rooms from Midnight to 7:00am. All daughters should be in their assigned room by Midnight (except for HIKE dance and Coronation Ball). Please respect those around you.

Safety & Security:

Please be respectful of the hotel and the rights of other guests. Your hotel room door should remained locked at all times. Damages to your room will be billed to those who made the reservations. In case of a life threatening emergency, call 911. You must be at least 21 years of age to gamble or be on the premises of the Valley Forge Casino.

Smoking Policy:

Valley Forge Casino Resort is a smoke free facility. We ask that all smokers must be at least 20 feet away from all hotel entrances and daughters.
