# Supreme Arts and Crafts Competition 2018-2019

## GENERAL RULES

Please read the general rules for the competition as well as the specific guidelines for each category. If you have any questions, please contact Chris Seets, Chairman, by either phone or by email.

### 1. AGE GROUPS

The following categories will NOT be broken down into specific judging: Promotion

All other categories will be judged under the specific age groups as follows:

- Jobie-to-Bee
- 10 – 14
- 15 – 19

2. The daughter's age as of the registration deadline, July 6, 2019, determines which age group the daughter should enter. Jobie-to-Bee may enter all categories.
3. Job's Daughter contestants submitting entries must be in good standing with JDI as of August 7, 2019. The contestant must have made the entry during the current Supreme Guardian Council year, August 2018 – August 2019.
4. PRE-REGISTRATION: ALL items entered in the competition MUST be pre-registered. The pre-registration form may be emailed or mailed to the Chairperson. The deadline to pre-register is July 6, 2019. This will help the committee obtain an accurate count of awards for each category.
5. All pre-registration forms must be email dated or postmarked no later than July 6, 2019 to:

6. The Chairman will acknowledge all email pre-registrations by a return email. If you wish acknowledgement of a mailed registration, please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope.
7. ENTRY SUBMISSION PROCEDURE: A sealed envelope must be attached to each entry with the following information listed on the outside of the envelope: Daughter's age and category. The inside of the envelope should contain the actual entry form.
8. Mailed entries MUST be postmarked by July 6, 2019.

9. All other entries are to be submitted at the Overland Park Convention Center, Lower Level in Overland Park, Kansas starting on Sunday, August 4, 2019, between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., but no later than Tuesday, August 6, 2019 at 4:00 p.m. Please check the actual Session information at the hotel for an adjustment to the time someone will be available. Please read the rules and guidelines for each category. Failure to comply with these rules will result in disqualification of the entry. The Supreme Arts and Crafts Committee reserves the right to disqualify an entry at its discretion based on content in keeping with the rules and regulations of Job's Daughters International.
10. A contestant may enter only one item per Category. The contestant does not need to be in attendance at Supreme Session to enter. The name of the person responsible for picking the entry must be clearly stated.
11. Each contestant determines which division and category she wishes her entry to be judged. However, the Arts and Crafts Committee reserves the right to adjust categories.
12. Entries must be presented to the Arts and Crafts Committee by Tuesday, August 6, 2019 before 4:00 p.m. Check the location of the Arts and Crafts competition in the Session program and/or newspaper. No late entries will be accepted unless caused by a travel emergency.
13. The entry must be as described on the registration form; substitutions will not be accepted.
14. Entry forms must be legible or will not be accepted.
15. Contestants are responsible for storing their own packing material. Packing material left in the competition room will be discarded.
16. Judging will be done during the evening of Tuesday, August 6, 2019. No viewing of the entries will be allowed before or during the judging.
17. Judging will be based on the following, as applicable: originality, design, artistry, presentation/layout, degree of difficulty, craftsmanship, neatness, and finishing. Completed judging score sheets will be given to the contestants. The decision of the judges is final.
18. The competition room will be open for viewing Wednesday, August 7 and Thursday, August 8 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. All entries must remain in the competition room during this time.
19. Entries must be claimed from the committee on Friday, August 9 between 12:00 – 4:00 p.m. unless other arrangements have been made with the Arts and Crafts Committee Chairman.
