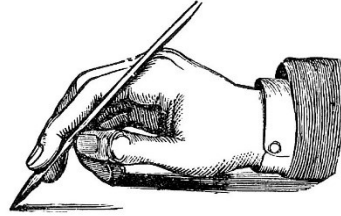

- 4) Mail three (3) copies of each entry, unless you submit electronically. If you are submitting via email, please make sure each entry is formatted in a Word document or a PDF.
- 5) Entries must be postmarked on or by **July 6, 2019**. Electronic entries must be sent no later than July 6, 2019.

  - 2) Double space
  - 3) Length should be no more than one (1) page typed
  - 4) Your Name, Bethel, or Location should **NOT** appear on the piece
  - 5) Piece must have been written during the 2018-19 Supreme Guardian Council year

### **Category: New Member Essay**

**Entrant:** Any Daughter who has been initiated since Supreme Session 2018. Age categories will be determined based on the number of entries.

**Theme:** Now that you are a member of Job's Daughters, share what you have learned on your journey as a Job's Daughter and what your favorite Job's Daughters moment has been so far.

- Requirements:**
- 1) Use size 12 Times New Roman or Ariel font
  - 2) Double space
  - 3) Length should be no more than three (3) pages typed
  - 4) Your Name, Bethel, or Location should **NOT** appear on the piece

### **Category: Essay**

**Entrant:** Age 10-12, age 13-15, and age 16-20

**Theme:** The theme for this year's Supreme Team is "There's no place like Job's Daughters". What has Job's Daughters taught you that you believe you couldn't have learned elsewhere, and how are these skills preparing you for the real world?

- Requirements:**
- 1) Use size 12 Times New Roman or Ariel font
  - 2) Double space
  - 3) Length should be no more than three (3) pages typed
  - 4) Your Name, Bethel, or Location should **NOT** appear on the piece
  - 5) Piece must have been written during the 2018-19 Supreme Guardian Council year

**Theme:** Write an acrostic poem using the base words "Job's Daughters". You may **NOT** use any wording or phrasing from the Honored Queen's initiation part; *if done, the entry will be disqualified.*

- Requirements:**
- 1) Use "Job's Daughters" as base words
  - 2) May **NOT** use wording or phrasing from the Honored Queen's initiation part
  - 3) Use size 12 Times New Roman or Ariel font
  - 4) Double space
  - 5) Length should be no more than three (3) pages typed
  - 6) Your Name, Bethel, or Location should **NOT** appear on the piece
  - 7) Piece must have been written during the 2018-19 Supreme Guardian Council year.

### **Category: Creative Writing**

**Entrant:** Age 10-12, age 13-15, and age 16-20

**Theme:** Write a short story utilizing either the Supreme Bethel Honored Queen's theme of "Ohana means family" or the Miss International Job's Daughters theme of "You hold the key to your own adventure."

- Requirements:**
- 1) Use one of the themes listed above
  - 2) Use size 12 Times New Roman or Ariel font
  - 3) Double space
  - 4) Length should be no more than three (3) pages typed
  - 5) Your Name, Bethel, or Location should **NOT** appear on the piece
  - 6) Piece must have been written during the 2018-19 Supreme Guardian Council year.
